

t is the responsibility of the Diocesan Board of Finance to develop a financial strategy that supports the Monmouth 2020 Vision and provide sustainable resources for future ministry in our Diocese.

The strategy needs to take into account the declining congregations and year-by-year reduction in income from Share. Therefore, Ministry Areas will need to become more self-sufficient in balancing their income with the costs for ministry and support. During the transition period to the new structure the Church in Wales and the Diocese are supporting Ministry Areas with additional funds for care of churches, administration centres, training, stewardship programmes and the establishment of different forms of ministry (lay, pioneer, children, youth and family)

Transformation

ransformation funding made available through Church in Wales 2020 Vision development has allowed the diocese to invest in three new Children, Youth and Family Ministry Advisers and a Pioneer Ministry Development Officer. They are actively working with local churches and communities in supporting them to grow and nurture their ministry as well as offering a range of diocesan training events.

In addition Pam Richards has recently taken up the new role of School Chaplain at Caldicot, where each weekday morning she's on hand for the pastoral needs of 1400 pupils and the teaching staff, as well as being involved in faith based activities and learning.

Ministry Share

n 2016 we begin to roll out a new Ministry Share scheme following consultations with parishes and the recommendations of a working group which met in 2015.

The new scheme is designed to more effectively resource our planned new Ministry Area structures and better reflects the spread of ministry across the diocese. Retained within the new scheme is the popular option to make payments via Standing Order and receive a 5% rebate to your church. Introduced during 2015 this feature has now been taken up by over 70% of parishes.
