



Insurance Excess - Multiple Claims Grant

If your church suffered damage in last week's storms and is now facing an insurance claim but has already made one recently, please consider applying for our Insurance Excess - Multiple Claims Grant.



This grant can reimburse parishes/MAs for insurance excess costs, suffered as a result of two or more successful claims being made for any reason, on the same church building, within a reasonable time frame (eg 12 – 18 months).

Good News Worth Sharing

Heart of Monmouthshire Ministry Area *Forward Together - United in Prayer*



Representatives from across the ministry area who currently write and pray intercessions met recently in St Cadoc's Church, Raglan to discuss the way forward with this ministry.

It was agreed by the meeting that a weekly rota will be drawn up with one person each week tasked with writing prayers of intercession.

These will be circulated to all twenty churches, for inclusion in all Sunday Services - this will be especially welcomed by those churches who do not currently have anyone writing intercessions

There will of course be time allowed for amendments to be made as appropriate to fit the needs of individual churches - the joyful news is that essentially we will be united in prayer across the whole ministry area each and every Sunday.

These sessions are for all who hold an ecclesiastical office, or who hold licence/PTO/commission from the Diocesan Bishop (whether lay or ordained), for those who run Sunday School or Youth clubs, Organists/Directors of Music, for whom an enhanced DBS is required.

The training is presented in two parts, Part 1 & Part 2, to complete the course both parts must be attended. The course lasts for approximately 2-2.5 hours and there is no cost to attend the course. **Please note Module A must be completed first.**

Or would you like to give your prayer a renewed focus for a week in Lent?
Would you like a little help along the way?

Then the **Week of Guided Prayer Online 2022** is for you.

This **Week of Guided Prayer Online** is suitable for everybody.

You will use Bible passages, and other material, as a basis for prayer and meditation, with a guide alongside you to suggest what you might pray with and to hear how it went.

that works for both of you. These sessions usually last 20-30 minutes and we suggest that you make 20-30 minutes available for the prayer itself. The retreat ends with a closing session online.
