asks of us; may God continue to bless you in all that you are and all that you do in your service of the gospel.




Safeguarding Advice - Warm Spaces

Launch of New Team Building Grant

Good team working is very important for the success of our ministry areas. During 2023, we hope that all ministry areas will have the opportunity to bring together their key teams to build relationships and foster good working practices.

To support this, we are launching a new grant scheme so that each ministry area will be able to apply for up to \pounds 1000 for team building. New Church Service in Spanish

Beechwood Ministry Area are launching an experimental service in the Spanish language at St. John's, Maindee,

But if there's anyone interested out there – whatever your level (or lack thereof) of Spanish – we would love to welcome both established speakers and those who, like Fr. William Ingle-Gillis, are just looking for opportunities to use a skill they've learned. Even if you're just curious, the experience of praying in another language opens fresh doors (as

we're sure our local Welsh learners will happily attest).

Whether or not you come, we seek your prayers that God will make something good out of the attempt, even — perhaps especially — something unexpected.

Climate Leadership Training - February 2023

The Church in Wales are pleased to be working in partnership with Tearfund to offer Climate Leadership Training in February next year.

The online Zoom course is over three evenings – 2nd, 9th and 16th February (7.30pm – 9pm)

- 2nd February Dr Ruth Valerio (Saying Yes to Life: The Archbishop of Canterbury's Lent Book 2020) will be the speaker for the first session on theology.
- 9th February The second Thursday evening will focus on practical action
- 16th February The final session is on climate-related missional activities

The course is intended for an adult audience – no under eighteens; however, diocesan youth leaders, working with young people, are specifically encouraged to attend.

Ideally, it would also be good if people could accompany others within their particular congregations so that an eco-support group could be formed in each after the training – if one does not already exist at the local church level.

SAVE THE DATE: Ministry Area Networks

Over the past two years a huge amount of your hard work has gone into forming our Ministry Areas and the Bishop, Standing Committee and DBF are very grateful for everything you have done. By the end of January 2023, all of our sixteen Ministry Areas will be formed.

One of the benefits of working as Ministry Areas is that it will enable closer relationships throughout our diocese. A diocese that encompasses the varied communities of the Valleys, Newport, Monmouthshire and parts of Cardiff. Starting in February 2023, we will establish networks for key roles in each Ministry Area so that we can better learn from one another and allow an opportunity for everyone's voice to be heard. With only sixteen Ministry Areas, these will be small networks where we will have an opportunity to discuss current issues facing our churches.

Ministry Area Wardens' Network – Both Ministry Area Wardens for each Ministry Area will be invited to St Mary's, Croesyceiliog on the 2nd March at 7pm.

In addition to Ministry Area Wardens, the Archdeacons and Diocesan Secretary will be present at this meeting.

Ministry Area Safeguarding Lead Network – each Ministry Area Safeguarding lead will be invited to St Mary's Priory, Abergavenny on the 16th March at 7pm.

In addition to Ministry Area Safeguarding Leads, members of the Provincial Safeguarding Team, the Archdeacons and Diocesan Secretary will be present at this meeting.

Lay-Co Chairs' Network – Each Ministry Area Lay Co-Chair will be invited to St Peter's, Blaina on the 23rd March at 7pm.

In addition to Lay Co-Chairs, the Bishop, Archdeacons and Diocesan Secretary will be present at this meeting.

Ministry Area Property Lead Forum – each Ministry Area Property Lead will be invited to St Michael's, Mitchel Troy on the 30th March at 7pm. In addition to Ministry Area Property Leads, the Archdeacons, Diocesan Secretary and Diocesan DAC and Property Officer will be present at this meeting.

Spring Diocesan Conference

The purpose of the Spring Conference will be to agree changes to the Diocesan Constitution necessary to implement the Deanery motion passed at our 2022 October Conference - making Deaneries co-terminus with Ministry Areas. The Spring Conference will also be asked to debate a paper proposing streamlining our diocesan committee structures with the aim of improving our decisionmaking structures. Following the debate in March a motion could be brought to the October 2023 Diocesan Conference.

Because we know that time is precious, we have amalgamated our Spring Conference with a half-day team building session for Ministry Teams, MA Wardens and Lay Co-Chairs with Bishop John Lomas providing the keynote address. Both events will take place St Teilo's High School on Saturday 11th March and Conference members are very welcome to stay for Bishop John's address.

Lunch will be provided for both events following Bishop John's address so it will also be an excellent opportunity to socialize with friends and colleagues from across the diocese.
