
Rev'd Samuel Patterson finished as Curate in the Netherwent Ministry Area on 15th January.

North Monmouthshire MA Inauguration



St Teilo's in Llantillio Crossenny hosted the 14th of the 16 ministry area inauguration services for the diocese, as the North Monmouthshire Ministry Area was formally launched.

In a full church, four people, representing different areas of the new grouping,

spoke of the journey so far for the ministry area, mentioning some of the challenges and fears but also how well people had already begun to come together. An example of this was the ministry area 'Pop Up Choir' led by Philip Norman, who were singing at their third service in the area and which has been a real success in bringing people together, as well as enhancing the worship. A presentation was also made by the Bishop to Leila, a 5 year old from one of the local schools, who won the competition to design a new logo for the Ministry Area.

In the service, the Bishop spoke of recognising the challenges faced already and also of the need for more work ahead, but assured those present of the benefits of building lasting relationships through the conversations that will take place over the coming months, something which other Ministry Areas have already begun to experience.


A really positive service was followed by wonderful refreshments and an enjoyable time of fellowship.

Quiet Days at Tymawr Convent

The Society of the Sacred Cross Tymawr Convent

Centenary Year of Women of Prayer

On St. Telio's Day 1923, a small group of women came from Chichester, West Sussex, to Tymawr, near Monmouth, to begin a life of contemplative prayer dedicated to God and living off the land. The present day community of contemplative sisters invite you to join them in this programme of Quiet Days honouring Women of Prayer. The Quiet Days are open to all.

There will be 7 Quiet Days in 2023, starting on Saturday **11 February 2023** entitled **Contemplative Prayer and Mission led by Dr. Jane Williams** who is McDonald Professor in Christian Theology at St Mellitus College. She is the author of a number of books, including *Lectionary Reflections; Why Did Jesus have to Die?;* and *The Art of Christmas.* Introducing the Quiet Day, Jane writes: "Whether we notice it or not, our practice of prayer is deeply connected to the character and purposes of God. Far from being a private, life-style choice, to be a pray-er is to be drawn into the action of God for the world."

The first **Quiet Day** begins at 10.00am (the Office of Morning Prayer at 9.30am is optional), followed by our speaker for the day and time for rest and prayer before the midday Eucharist. After a 'bring your own' lunch, our speaker will lead the afternoon session, which will end after Vespers at 4.00pm.

Safeguarding Training Dates

Safeguarding Courses will be available across the Diocese in 2023 to ensure that everyone has the right level of up to date training for their role and has a good understanding of their role in Safeguarding in the Church.

Module A is available online and can be undertaken independently without a trainer and without booking. The course is designed to support all of us within our church communities and aims to equip everyone to help make the church – and keep the church – a safe place. It should be completed by all clergy, everyone with a church office and anyone requiring further safeguarding training. Bookkeeper/Administrator for Monmouth Marches Ministry Area

A Bookkeeper/Administrator is needed for the new Monmouth Marches Ministry Area. This came into existence in January 2023 and unites 19 Church in Wales parishes into one group led by the Ministry Area Leader, Revd. Tim Dack and managed by a Ministry Area Council. The post is initially for one year and for 6 hours per week.

The Bookkeeper will work closely with the Ministry Area Treasurer, Mr Steve Martin, to develop and maintain the financial records for the ministry area and its churches and to assist in some administrative functions. The initial focus will be on establishing the financial systems.

This is a new post and will develop and possibly change as the ministry area becomes established and develops. The ministry area covers all the Church in Wales churches and halls, from Monmouth to Tintern, Llanishen, Dingestow, and St Maughan's. The post holder may work two three-hour sessions weekly and be based in Monmouth. There will also be an expectation that the bookkeeper may attend approximately one meeting per month with local church treasurers and/or other ministry area members.

It is an exciting opportunity to play a significant role in bringing the churches together and establishing simple but effective working arrangements. Applicants will need to be well organised, able to handle confidential information and be self-motivated.
