


Designed for children, it offers an invitation to come & explore the wonderful variety of minibeasts hidden around your churchyard. It's suitable to use anytime during the year, but is perfect for these summer months when so many small but mighty creatures are inhabiting our churchyards.

The Trail consists of 12 A4 printable posters, featuring 10 minibeasts commonly found in UK churchyards. There are fun facts to discover about each creature, plus 10 engaging activities for children to explore, alongside a relevant Bible verse.

The Trail also includes a welcome sign for you to encourage families to explore the trail, & a final poster which shares 5 simple actions we can all take to help the wildlife around us.

**Ordinations 2023** 



### Quiet Day at Tymawr - Saturday 3rd June

On St. Telio's Day 1923, a small group of women came from Chichester, Surrey, to Tymawr, near Monmouth, to begin a life of contemplative prayer dedicated to God and living off the land. The present day community of contemplative sisters invite you to join them in this centenary year in **Quiet Days honouring Women of Prayer**. The Quiet Days are open to women and and men; there is no charge.

The next Quiet Day on 3 June 2023 is entitled 'Teresa of Cartegena and God in the Silence'. It will be lead by the Venerable Karen Lund, who is Archdeacon of Manchester. She is a poet, mystic and lover of God and trees. She is also a creative felter, basket weaver and horsewoman.

The day begins at 10.00 – 10.30am for registration and coffee (the Office of Morning Prayer at 9.30am is optional), followed by a talk and time for meditation, or a walk in the grounds, and prayer before the midday Eucharist. After a 'bring your own' lunch, our speaker will lead the afternoon session, which will end after Vespers and tea at 4.30pm.



### **Safeguarding Training Dates**

Safeguarding Courses will be available across the diocese in 2023 to ensure that everyone has the right level of up to date training for their role and has a good understanding of their role in Safeguarding in the Church.

Module A is available online and can be undertaken independently without a trainer and without booking. The course is designed to support everyone

within our church communities and aims to equip us in helping to help make the church – and keep the church – a safe place. It should be completed by all clergy, everyone with a church office and anyone requiring further safeguarding training. 
