Wendy Lemon, the Church's Safeguarding Manager, says the day will be a chance to ensure people know how to report any concerns they have. "We encourage churches to use the resources available from the Church in Wales and thirtyone:eight to take some time in their service on November 19th to highlight and pray for safeguarding within our churches. By the end of Safeguarding Sunday we hope people will know who their Ministry or Mission Area Safeguarding Officers are and how to report any concerns they have. We also hope that they will have been reminded that safeguarding is a central part of the Christian faith."
