Ecumenical and Interfaith Officer Announcement

We are delighted to announce that the Bishop of Monmouth has appointed Revd Canon Andrew Lightbown as Ecumenical and Interfaith Officer for the diocese.

Andrew was installed as Canon Residentiary at Newport Cathedral last year and will represent the Diocese of Monmouth as part of The Ecumenical and Interfaith Officers' Network (EION), convened by the Church in Wales.

Speaking about his appointment, he said: "I am delighted to be appointed to this role.



For the church to prosper, thrive, and serve its communities it is important that all people of goodwill, from across the denominational and faith spectrum, pull together, work together, and pray together. The diocese has a rich religious history and the time feels right to honour our past, encourage each other in the present, and move forward together with respect, as we seek to serve the communities to which we have all been called."

The bulk of the work is within the diocese itself with the main focus being on 'grass roots' work within the various local contexts. As a Cathedral Canon,

Andrew's first task will be to develop links in the city of Newport. Attending meetings of the EION will provide updates on more provincial matters and our work with ecumenical and interfaith partners here in Wales and across the world.



New Vicar for Liturgy and Worship

Last Thursday evening, Revd Marja Flipse was welcomed to East Cardiff Ministry Area as their new Vicar for Liturgy and Worship at a licensing service held in St Mellons. It was such a wonderful evening - thanks so much to all who played a part in the preparations!




HT PRISONS WEEK A WEEK OF PRAYER

Diocesan Link with The Highveld

On 19th November 2003, the Bishop of Monmouth and the Bishop of The Highveld (South Africa) signed an agreement, linking our two dioceses for five years. This link has been maintained for the past 20 years, with visitors back and forth, and at this month's Diocesan Conference, members will be voting for the link to be continued for another 5 years.

The aim of the link is:

- to strengthen mission and evangelism in the church communities of both dioceses
- to increase awareness of our solidarity in the cause of Christ
- to respect, and learn of and from each other's cultural heritage
- to enable the world to recognise more clearly God's mission



Resources



Grants

Looking after church buildings and running successful mission and outreach projects takes money. We know that at some time or another, all churches need help with grant funding and fundraising. As a diocese we have a range of grant schemes which are overseen by our diocesan committees. We can also signpost to external funders.

Diocesan Grants

Churches can apply for the following grants every two years and their details can be found on our website **here**. The next application deadline is the 15th of November.

- Church Fabric & Church Hall apply for up to £5,000 for works to a church hall or £8,000 for a church building
- **Churchyard Improvement** apply for up to £2,000 for works in a churchyard
- Insurance Excess: Multiple Claims apply for up to £500 to cover your insurance excess if you are having to make a second claim within an 18-month period

We also have a Social Responsibility Fund. Churches can apply to this fund every year and there is no maximum limit for grant awards.

External funders
