Newly Licensed Ministers

The newly licensed ministers had a reflective and thought provoking day this week, spending some time quietly with God in preparation for the busy build up through Advent to Christmas.



Bishop Cherry began the day with a gentle and thoughtful Holy Eucharist before the Revd Philip Averay led the rest of the day. There were four themes - the words we know as our advent themes - love, joy, hope, and waiting. We listened to scripture and a short reflection before finding our own space to consider, *"Why did you fall in love with Jesus? What brings you joy? How can you find hope?"*

We rest in the strength of God as we wait for His coming this Christmas. Spending the time quietly with God was refreshing and the questions were challenging. We all found something to ponder upon and agreed that we finished the day closer to God than when we started it.

Bishops' Christmas Appeal

The Church in Wales bishops are urging congregations to support a Christmas Appeal to help those affected by the war in the Holy Land.

The Appeal, launched by the charity <u>Friends of the Holy Land</u>, is raising money to support Christian projects and humanitarian aid in Gaza, Israel, the West Bank and East Jerusalem. It has already received a donation of £5,000 from the Church in Wales' Overseas Mission Fund.

Donations will:

- Help local Christians show the love of Jesus in practical ways by supporting the basic needs of people of all faiths who are sheltering in churches in Gaza.
- Pay for essential medical equipment and supplies to help ill and injured people at the Al-Ahli Hospital in Gaza, which is managed by the Episcopal Church in Jerusalem.
- Enable ongoing projects to continue in the West Bank, Gaza, East Jerusalem and Israel through this turbulent period and beyond.
